#### All weather Mt Pleasant Green

As members will have noticed there is significant wearing on the green as a result of constant play in the direction of the service station. In an effort to spread the wear the rinks were shifted to playing towards the natural green. Unfortunately the rink markers are repeatedly shifted back to the original position. This is very frustrating and annoying as the sole reason for the change is to prolong the life of the green surface. The cost of a replacement carpet is in the vicinity of \$300,000 so it is in the best interest of the club to prolong the life of the existing green. I ask for the cooperation of all members in this matter. All rollups, practice and social events are to be played parallel to the club rooms. Please do not change the direction of play sign or reposition the rink markers.

The natural green will be open for club championship and inter club games after its reconfiguration is complete. Thank you all for your patience as we waited for the weather to warm up so the grass would start to grow. The constant flooding that occurred in July didn't help us.

The exterior work arranged to re-align the natural green, replacement concrete areas and grass edges, the installation of decking and handrails and two sets of new sliding stacker aluminium windows will commence on **Monday 14th November** and be completed in 5 weeks prior to Christmas.

The area of parking at the bar end of the building will be required for contractors use and their vehicles.

**Safety precautions**: Please remember that our green and the area in front of the clubrooms will be a work site and all safety precautions and signage should be adhered to by all members and visitors.

The internal work to build the new bar and refit and decorate the interior of our facilities will commence immediately after the New Year break and the aim is to have this completed by **Friday 10th March**. This will include additional lighting to both ends of the building. All normal activities will continue but please remember to obey all safety requirements during this time.

**The major relaunch** of Club Redcliffs will include a community fundraising event over two days in support of the Redcliffs School, Canterbury West Coast Air Rescue Trust and Club Redcliffs on the weekend of 11th and 12th March. More detail will follow soon.
